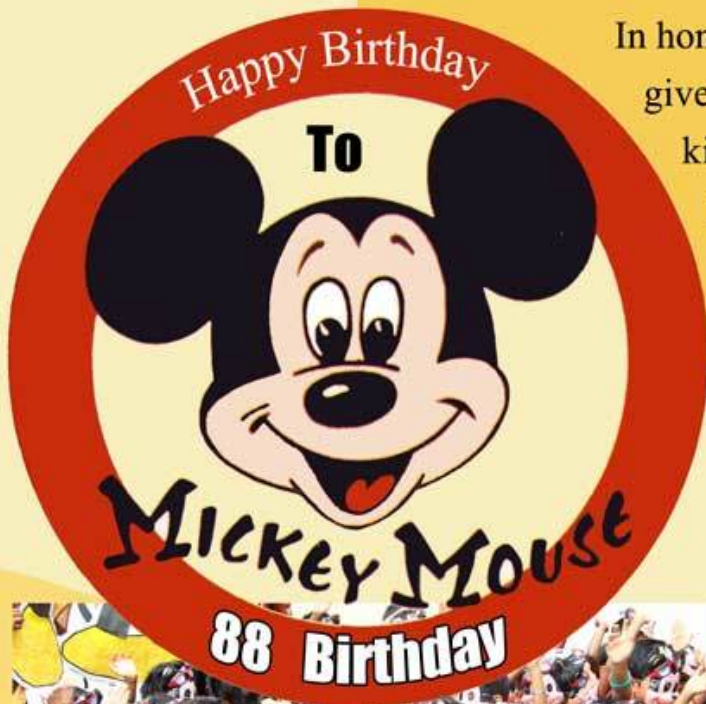


Pongal is celebrated as 'Harvest Festival' thanking our God for his fruitful blessings.
